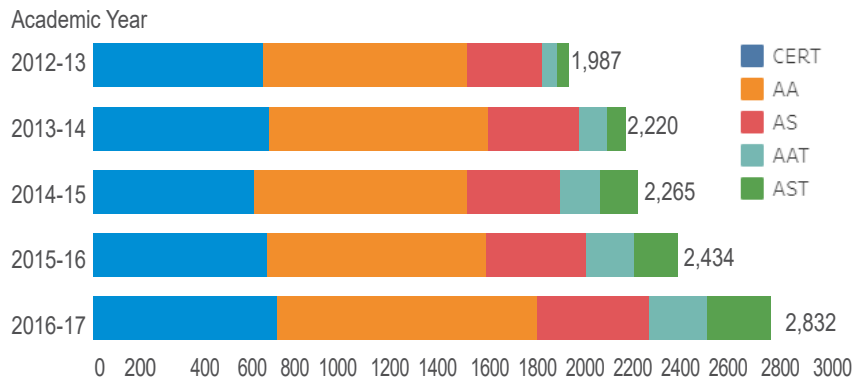

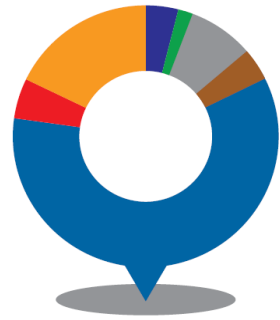

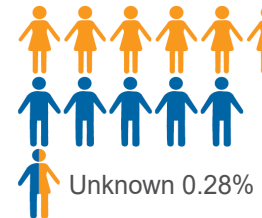
## Fall 2018 Unduplicated Enrollment Demographic

Gender

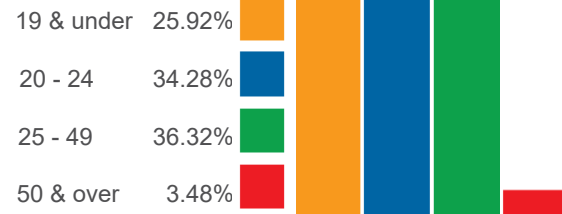


Female 57.31%

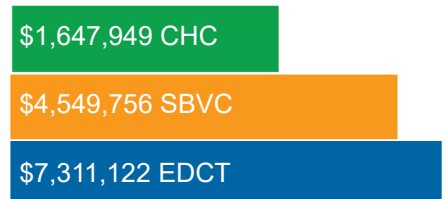
